Combined Control Store for Content and Metadata

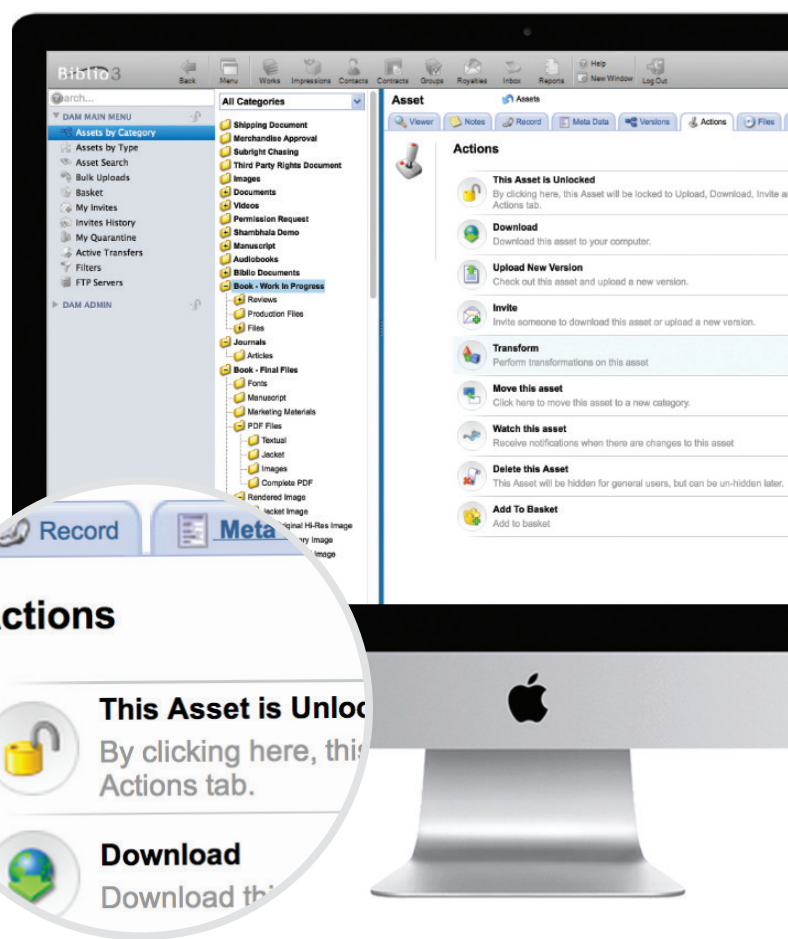

Workflow Tools to Aid Production and Management of Digital Assets

Digital assets can be automatically uploaded from pick-up folders on individual computers and shared drives and then assigned to the relevant bibliographic record within Biblio3 and BiblioLIVE.

Powerful tools ease the creation and management of digital content, for example, content can be repurposed, converted and extracted.

Integration with Biblio's comprehensive scheduling facility means schedule stages can be automatically updated when assets are uploaded or downloaded.

Easily Share Assets With Third Parties, Websites and Satellite Systems

BiblioDAM provides unique file transfer and robust methods to share assets with third parties, websites, social media and satellite systems. Quality assurance verifies that files aren't corrupt and resource forks in Mac files are retained with no data being lost.

All assets in BiblioDAM can be referenced via URL, and all bibliographic metadata stored alongside an asset can be output in XML, enabling assets and metadata to be easily fed to websites. Maintaining this information is also

simplified with changes made in the Biblio suite being reflected onto websites. Examples could include anything from author photos, event videos, audio and book readings.

Supports Collaborative Working

BiblioDAM includes a selection of tools that support communication and collaborative working, for example, files can be locked, commented on and watermarked. The system also supports authorisation workflows, password protection for digital assets and version control allowing users to revert to previous versions or statuses at any time.

BiblioDAM as a Picture Library and Sales Tool

BiblioDAM has the ability to invite external users to browse parts of the system on a read-only basis. This enables invited individuals to view selected material avoiding FTP transfers etc. Selected assets can be added to a basket and time limits can be specified should the access need to be limited.

BiblioDAM and eBooks - Digital Rights Management

BiblioDAM can communicate with DRM software such as Adobe® Content Server 4 and/or relevant widgets on websites to aid the sale of eBooks.
